## SHOW RULES \& REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. Entry Fees - $£ 2$ per dog per class - Pairs $£ 4$-Camping $\mathfrak{£ 1 0 . 0 0}$ per unit per Weekend, i.e. Fri \& Sat. N.B. camping will be limited to 75 units due to limited space. These will be allocated as entries are received. Arrival on Friday evening to be before 22.00 hrs .
3. Prizes: As shown in schedule.
4. The Committee or its appointed representatives reserves to itself the right to refuse entries, to prohibit any dog not in a fit state for competition through any cause.
5. Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests.
6. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
7. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
8. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
9. Dogs must not wear slip chains, collars or leads when under test.
10. Should a Judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge and split classes where deemed necessary.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
12. Kennel Club Standard Marking will apply in all cases.
13. The height of the jump obstacles will be 30 ins in Standard classes, 20 ins in Midi classes and 15 ins in Mini classes.
14. A Judge at an Agility test or Flyball competition cannot compete or enter a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership, at that event.
15. Withdrawal of Dogs from Test: A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is:-
a. A bitch which is in season
b. Suffering from any infections or contagious disease.
c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
16. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 7 days before the date of closing of entries, i.e. 27 th July 2003 shall be counted when entering for any class.
17. It is the competitors responsibility to be available for their class and running order and to wear their Ring Card whilst competing.
18. A dog must, at the time of entry for the competition, be registered as required by K.C. Rules and Regulations in the competitors name. In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given.
19. Should circumstances so dictate the society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
20. In the event of the abandonment of the Show through circumstances beyond our control, Daventry DTC may defray such expenses from the entry fees to cover the cost of show preparation.
21. No dog will be allowed in the ring at any time other than when being judged. No practising will be allowed in the ring.
22. The Committee reserves the right to split any classes where number of entries warrant it.
23. All dogs will be entered at this Show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Committee will not accept responsibility for the loss, damage, or injury, however caused, to dogs, people or property whilst at this show.
24. In all matters concerning the competition, the Judges decision is final. In all other matters the decision of the show organisers is final.

## DOGS IN CARS AT SHOWS ON HOT DAYS.

Please be aware of the following Kennel Club advice:-
It is considered that the act of causing suffering to a dog as a result of it being left in a car by an exhibitor or the owner of a registered dog on a hot day could be considered discreditable or prejudicial to the interests of the canine world and could form the basis of a case under Kennel Club Rule A42.

## Do Not leave your Dogs in a Car or Van without adequate ventilation and water. Check that your Dogs are OK at regular intervals. <br> ELIGIBILITY OF CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prize wins are those gained at any Kennel Club Open licensed event. (i.e. invitation events and special classes excepted).

Agility classes to include contact points and Jumping classes where there are not contact obstacles. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

ELEMENTARY For owners, handlers or dogs which have not won a $1 \mathrm{st} / 2 \mathrm{nd} / 3$ rd prize in an Agility and/or Jumping Class at a licensed Agility Test.
STARTERS For owners, handlers or dogs which have not won an Agility and / or Jumping Class at a licensed Agility Test (Elementary excepted).
NOVICE For dogs which have not won a total of two first prizes in Novice, Intermediate, Advanced or Open at a licensed Agility Test. (Elementary \& Starters excepted)
INTERMEDIATE Open to all except dogs eligible for Elementary and Starters Classes at a licensed Agility Test.
SENIOR Open to all dogs having won at least two first prizes at a licensed Agility Test, one of which must be an Agility class. (Starters and Elementary excepted)
OPEN Open to all.
MINI Open to dogs measuring $\mathbf{1 5}$ inches or less at the shoulder.
MIDI Open to dogs measuring between 15 and 17 inches at the shoulder.

Daventry D.T.C. Reserve the right to change judges and appoint others as appropriate.
Rosettes will be awarded to at least $10 \%$ in each class. Trophies $1^{\text {st }}-3^{\text {rd }}$ in all classes.
The Belinda Reynolds Perpetual Trophy will be presented to the highest placed crossbreed dog in Starters Agility.

Veteran Classes for dogs over 9 years old will have no A-frame and lower jumps. Helpers classes are for competing dogs of standard height that cannot enter any other classes.

## DIRECTIONS

## FROM J16 M1 (SOUTH)

Leave M1 at J16, take A45 (for approx 8 miles) to Daventry, through Upper Heyford, Flore and Weedon (at Weedon go straight on at traffic lights). When you reach Daventry at the first roundabout (by the Hotel and garage) take the 1st exit. At the next roundabout take the 3 rd exit. At the next roundabout take the 1 st exit into Royal Oak Way South, (passing Fords on your left). Carry on up the hill, you will then see Fords Sport \& Social Club on the left.

## FROM J18 M1 (NORTH)

Leave M1 at J18, take A361 to Daventry (approx 8 miles). When you reach Daventry at the first roundabout (by the Hanover International Hotel) take the 3rd exit. At next roundabout take the 2nd exit. At next roundabout take 1st exit. At next roundabout take the 3rd exit (into Prospect Way). At T junction turn right into Royal Oak Way North. You will see Fords Sports \& Social Club on the left.
N.B. Those people arriving after 22.00 hrs on Friday evening will be required to camp in an overnight area.
