ELIGIBILITY OF CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes prize wins are those gained at any Kennel Club Open licensed event (i.e. Limited agility tests, invitation events and special classes excepted). This classification applies to competitions for standard, medium and small dogs.

Standard Classes

Grade 1 (Elementary) – For owners, handlers or dogs who have not gained a first place in an Agility or three first places in a jumping class. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2 (Starters) – For owners, handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1, but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or 3 first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 .

Grade 3 (Graduate) – Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4,5,6 or 7.

Grade 4 (Novice) – Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 (Intermediate) – Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 (Senior) – Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 (Advanced) – Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

Special Classes

Junior:

CLASSES 4, 19, 22 and 33 Handlers must be under 12 years **OR** 12 years and over but under 18 years on the first day of the Show, 14th August 2007. Dogs may **not** be entered in both UNDER 12 and OVER 12 parts. Trophies in both parts. Dogs will run at their appropriate height; Small, Medium and Large. (Combined Grades 1 to 7)

CLASS 33 Handlers must be over 6 years on 14th August 2007. Standard marking to apply.

Special Combined Grades 1 to 7 Pairs Small & Medium

Class is open to small and medium dogs, pairs may be s/s, s/m or m/m and will be run as one class; a pair consists of 2 dogs and 2 handlers. Class may be Jumping/Agility, Agility/Agility or Jumping/Jumping as circumstances allow and at judge's discretion. Jump height max. 350 mm.

Special Combined Grades 1, 2 and 3 Pairs Large

Class open to large Grades 1, 2 and 3 dogs only; a pair consists of 2 dogs and 2 handlers. Class may be Jumping/Agility, Agility/Agility or Jumping/Jumping as circumstances allow and at judge's

discretion.

Special Combined Grades 4, 5, 6 and 7 Pairs Large

Class open to Large Grades 5, 6 and 7 dogs only; a pair consists of 2 dogs and 2 handlers. Class may be Jumping/Agility, Agility/Agility or Jumping/Jumping as circumstances allow and at judge's discretion.

Special Any Size Jumping

These classes are open to dogs of all sizes, **not entered** in any other classes at this show,

PART (a) SMALL/Medium for dogs measuring under 1ft 5ins (430mm) at the withers (Jump height max. 260mm);

PART (b) for dogs measuring over 1ft 5ins (430mm) at the withers (Jump height max. 350 mm); No long jump or tyre in either part; trophies to 1st place.

Special Welsh National Agility Handler 2007, Classes 1 and 9 (Combined Grades 1 to 7)

Classes are open to Large, Medium and Small dogs; owner or joint owners **and** handler must reside in Wales. Dogs must be run in both classes for faults and time from both classes to be added together; least overall faults and fastest aggregate time wins. [Elimination 100 faults]. *With special thanks to the **Western Mail** for sponsoring this competition.*

Special Open Helter Skelter Large and Small & Medium, Classes 31, 36 and 45 Special jumping classes open to Large Small and Medium dogs and grades as defined in the class list. Small and medium dogs run as one class.

Class 33: YKC "Agility Dog of the Year" Crufts 2008 Qualifying Heat. Trophies to 1st in each part. This Special Class will be divided into 2 age group parts Ages as at 14th August 2007; Dogs may only be entered in 1 age group part:

a) Handlers 6 - 11 years; b) Handlers 12 - 17 years.

*Handlers must be under 18 on 14th August 2007 Within each part there will be sections for **Large, Medium and Small** dogs. Combined Grades 1 to 7 The first in each section/part will be invited to **Crufts 2008** to compete in the semi-final for the **YKC Agility Dog of the Year 2008***

Class 16 Special Combined Grades 1 – 7 "Agility Chaos with Kelpies" Class open only to Kelpies.

Tournament

The Perpetual "**Golden Valley DTC**" **Welsh Challenge Trophy** will be won by the Welsh Club that aggregates the highest number of points from places in all classes at this Show. Points awarded as follows; classes with places, 1 – 20, 1st place 20 points, 2nd place 19 points etc; classes with places 1 – 6, 1st - 6 points, 2nd - 5 points etc.. The Club **MUST** be declared on the entry form and may not be altered after the closing date. The tournament is open to all clubs and training groups with main TRAINING VENUE in Wales. *(By kind permission of Golden Valley Dog Training Club.)*

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/ATC number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry fees all classes: £2.20p per dog / class (Classes 6, 15 and 34: £4.40 per pair)
3. Amount of prize money: Overall result of aggregate of Special Classes 1 and 9 – "Special Welsh National Agility Handler 2007", 1st Place: £50, 2nd Place: £25, and Best Junior £25.
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible to compete for Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests.
6. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
7. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
8. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
9. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the

10. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A flat close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
 11. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
 12. No competitor shall impugn the decision of a judge or judges.
 13. Sponsorship of classes is as follows;
Classes 1 and 9 The Western Mail, Class 33 Young Kennel Club.
All other classes: Pembrokeshire Agricultural Society; Veteran Specials: Barbara Roe
 14. Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations apply.
 15. The heights of the jump obstacles will be as defined in Kennel Club Regulations H(1)(B): Large dogs – 650 mm max., Medium dogs – 450 mm max., Small dogs – 350 mm max., *except for classes 7, 21 and 34* see definitions of classes above.
 16. The height limits for dogs
 - a.) Large dogs - For dogs measuring over 430 mm (1ft 5ins)
 - b.) Medium dogs - For dogs measuring over 350 mm (1 ft 1 1/2 ins) and measuring 430 mm (1 ft 5 ins) or under at the withers.
 - c.) Small dogs - for dogs measuring 350 mm (1 ft 1 1/2 ins) or under at the withers .
 17. Judges at an Agility Test may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Test at which they are judging.
 18. Withdrawal of dogs from Test

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is:-
A bitch that is in season.
Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
 21. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 7 days before the date of closing of entries (i.e. Friday 29th June 2007) shall be counted when entering for any class.
 22. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order.
 23. Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
 24. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. The Committee reserves the right to appoint further judges as necessary.
 25. A dog must, at the time of entry for the Competition, be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitors' name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete as the new owners' property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.
 26. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the shows can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned.
 27. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
 28. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
 29. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease –No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the

Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.

30. Animals in Event - No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.
However, at the discretion of the Society, a dog may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
31. Competitors must wear ring numbers when competing.
32. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
33. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the correct score is recorded on the scoresheet. Mistakes cannot be rectified after the class has closed.
34. Parents/guardians are responsible for the behaviour and safety of their children under 18.
35. In the event of cancellation and or abandonment the Committee reserves the right to defray from entries and income received, such costs as they deem are necessary.
36. Dogs are entered at the owners' risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Club, Committee and officials will accept no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury howsoever caused to dogs persons or property while at the Show.
37. Rosettes should be claimed at the Show.
38. Any dog which is of such a temperament or is so much out of hand or a real or potential danger to other dogs or people at the Show will be required to leave within one hour of the decision of the Competition management.
39. Please use the signed exercise area(s) having regard to other dogs and their owners, as well as members of the public.
40. Entries should be made on the official entry form or photocopies thereof.
