- 1 In the following definitions of classes First Prize wins in Limited Show Obedience Classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Obedience Classes.
- 2 A dog must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another class if desired, one special class expected.
- 3 In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class (Saturday 10th May 2008)

PRE-BEGINNERS:	To compete in Pre-Beginners a Handler or Dog must not have won a First Prize in either Pre-Beginners or Beginners nor gained a third place or above in any other obedience class.
BEGINNERS:	To compete in Beginners a Handler or Dog must not have won a total of two or more First Prizes in Beginners, or one First Prize in any other Obedience Class. (Pre-Beginners excepted)
NOVICE	For Dogs which have not won two First Prizes in Obedience Classes (Pre- Beginners and Beginners excepted)
CLASS A	For Dogs which have not won three First Prizes in Class A, B and Open Class C in total.
CLASS B	For Dogs which have not won three First Prizes in Class B and Open Class C in total.
CLASS C	Open to all Dogs.

NOVICE	For Dogs which have not won two First Prizes in Obedience Classes (Pre- Beginners and Beginners excepted)
CLASS A	For Dogs which have not won three First Prizes in Class A, B and Open Class C in total.
CLASS B	For Dogs which have not won three First Prizes in Class B and Open Class C in total.
CLASS C	Open to all Dogs.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
- 2 (a) The Show will open at **8.30am** (b) Judging will commence at **9.00 am**
- 3 Dogs will be received at any time. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management
- 4 The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
- 5 Entry Fees - £3.50 per dog entered and £1.00 for each subsequent entry. A block entry will be £10.00.
- 6 There will be no prize money awarded at this show.
- 7 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
9. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dog registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes, or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
- 10 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for competition at Kennel Club Licensed Obedience Shows
- 11 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is strictly forbidden.
- 12 No bitch in season is allowed to compete
- 13 A dog shall be disqualified and removed from the show if it is: (a) a bitch which is in season (b) suffering from any infectious or contagious disease (c) interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent (d) of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal (e) likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
- 14 After a dog has commenced competing in a class, no substitution of handler is permitted in that class.
- 15 No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show
- 16 Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
- 17 No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
- 18 Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to Kennel Club.
- 19 The maximum number of entries allowed in any class is 60. If the entry received exceeds 60, except for Championship Class C, the class shall be equally divided (to within one dog) by a draw. If the resulting individual class entry after division exceeds 60 a further division of the total class entry shall take place so that each equal division of the class is 60 or less. In all classes, other than Championship Class C, if the entry exceeds 50 the class may, at the discretion of the Society, be equally divided by a draw (to within one dog). If the resulting individual class entry, after division, exceeds 50 a further division of the total entry may take place so that each equal division of the class is 50 or less. Prize money for each division, which must be judged separately, shall be the same as that offered for the original class.
- 20 Where classes are divided, competitors entered therein shall be notified of all changes and timed stay exercises must not be held earlier than advertised for the original class.
- 21 Where timed stays will take place it must be announced in the Schedule that they will take priority over other tests. The times of such tests to be published at the Show and in the Catalogue. Timed stays must not commence before one hour after the published time for the commencement of judging.
- 22 For the duration of the Show and including those in the exercise area, all dogs must be on a lead except when competing or practising prior to competition.
- 23 **RUNNING ORDER** (i) Where a draw for the complete running order of Classes is not made, Show Management must conduct a ballot to determine a running order for at least the first 10 competitors/dogs in these classes. This may be reduced to 6 at shows with less than 200 dogs entered or where there are less than 25 dogs entered in a specific class. (ii) In classes where a complete or partial running order has been made the relevant competitors must be notified before the day of the Show. (iii) In Classes where there is not a full running order all competitors must personally report to the ringside of all classes entered and book in, by marking a list of entries within one hour of the scheduled time for the commencement of judging of the Class. In Classes where a full running order has been made competitors must book in on arrival at the Show. The class lists are to be provided by the Show Management and should be available from the stated opening time of the Show. Wherever possible, Ring Scoreboard Stewards shall be appointed to assist with this booking in procedure (iv) All published running orders must be strictly observed. Competitors reporting late will be excluded from competition unless they have previously reported to the Chief Steward that they are actually working a dog in Championship Class C or in the Stay test of another class.
- 24 No dog shall be allowed in the judging ring other than those competing in the class being judged.
- 25 Nothing shall be carried, worn or displayed by a handler or a dog during judging which is capable of indicating the identity of the owner or the dog, nor must anything be said or any action taken which identifies the dog other than by exhibit number.
- 26 Any dog which is not presented for stays or scent exercises when called for testing will be considered to have withdrawn from the class.
- 27 Food shall not be carried or given to a dog under test.
- 28 All offers of sponsorship or donation must be included with the name of the sponsors.
- 29 After the commencement of judging, the responsibility for dogs being brought to the ring to compete is entirely the competitors
- 30 No modifications will be made to this schedule, except by the permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible
- 31 Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged over four calendar months. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their full details recorded on the entry form.

ELIGIBILITY

In the following definitions of classes, first prize wins are those gained at any Kennel Club Open licensed event (i.e. invitation and special classes excepted). The classifications apply to large, medium and small dogs. **Owners/handlers of small and medium dogs must bring to the show their agility record books containing the officially recorded height of their dogs, as should owners/handlers of large dogs which were first entered for competition on or after 1 January 2006.** Agility classes to include contact points and jumping classes where there are no contact obstacles. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

Grade 1 (Elementary)	For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.
Grade 2 (Starters)	For owners, handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.
Grade 3 (Graduate)	Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows & dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.
Grade 4 (Novice)	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.
Grade 5 (Intermediate)	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.
Grade 6 (Senior)	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5 or 7.
Grade 7 (Advanced)	Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.
Special ABC	Open to all large dogs, except border collies, working sheep dogs and their crosses.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/Authority to Compete number will be required for each entry.
2. **Entry Fees are as stated on the schedule. There is no fee for NFC dogs.**
3. There is no prize money and the Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number. Any non UK entries without this number will be returned to the competitor.
5. Puppies under eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible to compete in Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. NFC dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
6. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
7. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show
8. **Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie, not attached by a ring.**
9. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
10. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
11. Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations apply – copy available on request and at the show.
12. Judges at an Agility Test may not enter for competition a dog, which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Test at which they are judging.
13. **A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is: -**
 - a. A bitch that is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal or likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
14. **It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order.**
15. The heights of the jump obstacles will be:
650mm (2ft 1.6ins) large dogs,
450mm (1ft 5.7ins) medium dogs
350mm (1ft 1.75ins) small dogs
16. Height limits for dogs will be:
Large Dogs – measuring over 430mm(1ft 5in) at the withers
Medium Dogs – measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75in) and 430mm(1ft 5in) or under at the withers
Small Dogs – measuring under 350mm (1ft 1.75in) at the withers
17. **Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.**
18. **Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.**
19. A dog must at the time of entry for the Competition be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitors' name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been **made at a Competition may compete as the new owners' property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.**
20. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. Precincts of the event are the rings and a distance of 2 metres bordering the rings.
21. No dog/bitch will be allowed in the ring at any time other than when being judged.
22. All dogs will be entered in the Show at their owners' risk and whilst every care will be taken the Committee will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury, however caused, to dogs, persons or property at the Show.
23. If circumstances make it necessary to cancel the Show, Bangor Dog Training Club reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
24. The owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control at the licensed venue, including its vicinity, car parks and approaches.
25. Incorrect entries will be returned.
