CONTAINING THE OFFICIALLY RECORDED HEIGHT OF THEIR DOGS.**

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. Warm up jumps and exercise area may be available for competitors. No practice will be allowed on agility equipment in the competition ring prior to competition. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the show will lead to automatic disqualification.
2. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter agility tests.
4. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
5. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class.
6. No bitch in season to be present at show.
7. Mating of bitches within the precincts of show grounds is forbidden.
8. Dogs must be kept under proper control at all times.
9. Collars are not to be worn while competing in agility tests.
10. Food shall not be given or carried in the ring.
11. Handlers will be permitted to walk the agility courses before judging commences.
12. Any article carried by the handler is subject to the judge's discretion, but must be indicated to the judge prior to the commencement of test.
13. **NO e-mail entries will be accepted. Entries will only be accepted when received on official entry form (or photocopy) complete with correct payment.**
14. **Each dog's registration number MUST be given on the entry form, otherwise the entry will be returned.**
15. **All competitors must show respect for the judge. Training rounds will only be allowed if prior permission has been given by the judge.**

OSCAR BALMORAL QUALIFIERS

The classes are open to all Grades 4–7 dogs, however **IN ORDER TO QUALIFY**, dogs and handlers must be resident in Ireland, Northern Ireland or the Isle of Man. Subject to the above, the top five dogs in the Oscar Agility and Jumping classes, and first dog in the Oscar Small Dog and Medium Dog Agility and Jumping classes will qualify for the Final in May 2010. However, it should be noted that any dog qualified to compete at Balmoral in 2010 **MUST** be registered with the Kennel Club

Large Dogs – 550–650mm
Medium Dogs – 350–450mm

Agility Grading System with Grade Allocation for Existing Agility Handlers & Dogs. Prior to 30th May 2009

	LARGE DOGS	SMALL & MEDIUM DOGS
GRADE 1	For dogs, owners or handlers who have not had a first place in any Agility Class	Dogs, owners or handlers who have not had a first place in any Agility Class
GRADE 2	For dogs, owners or handlers who are still eligible for Introductory Agility	Dogs who have a first prize in any Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Class
GRADE 3	For dogs who are still eligible for Preliminary Agility	Dogs who have two first prizes in any Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Class
GRADE 4	For dogs who are still eligible for Novice Agility and who have not won two or more first prizes in Novice Agility.	Dogs who have three first prizes in any Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Class
GRADE 5	For dogs who are still eligible for Novice Agility and who have two first prizes but have not won out of Novice Agility.	Dogs who have four first prizes in any Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Class
GRADE 6	For dogs who have had four first prizes in Novice Agility or one first prize in Open Agility but have not won out of Novice Agility	Dogs who have five first prizes in any Agility Class or who have a first prize in Premier Agility
GRADE 7	Existing Premier Dogs	Dogs who have six first prizes in any Agility Class or who have two first prizes in Premier Agility.

Note:

Grades 1 and 2 – Owner, handler and dogs' wins all contribute to eligibility
Grades 3 to 7 – Only the dogs' wins contribute to eligibility.

4. IN CONSIDERATION of my entry being accepted I hereby agree (1) to indemnify the Irish Kennel Club and/or its Trustees or its Officials in respect of any damage or loss from whatever source arising caused by or to any dog exhibited by me while in the precincts of the Show; (2) that any decision given concerning me by the Irish Kennel Club or by any Committee thereof in connection with any matter whatsoever arising through or at this Show, shall be communicated by the Secretary of the Irish Kennel Club to all whom at the sole discretion of the Irish Kennel Club, it may concern and that such a decision, together with a report of the proceedings in the matter may also be published together with my name and address and description.
5. I HEREBY UNDERTAKE to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club and of the Show.
6. I UNDERTAKE to indemnify the promoters against any claims arising out of my participation as competitor in the Show.
