***The Starters Heats are for the Finals of the Agility Club Starters Agility Challenge 2010 to be held in July 2010 at the Agility Club Show. The trophies and rosettes for the heats are sponsored by Pedigree and The Agility Club. Anyone eligible for Grades 1 and 2 may enter, but only *members of The Agility Club at the time of competing* may qualify for the Finals. The Show Secretary must be informed if a handler or dog that has already qualified for the same height Final is placed in a subsequent heat.**

ELIGIBILITY AND SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

In accordance with KC Rules, large dogs who have not competed before 1st January 2006 & ALL Small & Medium dogs must have been officially measured before competing at a KC licensed Agility show.

SMALL CLASSES: Only open to dogs which measure 35cm or less at the withers. Jump heights will be 35cm.

MEDIUM CLASSES: Only open to dogs which measure over 35cm but 43cm or under at the withers. Jump heights will be 45cm.

LARGE CLASSES: Only open to dogs which measure over 43cm at the withers. Jump heights will be 65 cm.

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to the dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1 (Elementary) – For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility or three first places in Jumping Classes at a Kennel Club Licensed Agility Show. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2 (Starters) – Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,,4,5,6,7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at a Kennel Club Licensed Agility Show. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 3 (Graduate) – Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 (Novice) – Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 (Intermediate) – Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 (Senior) – Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 (Advanced) – Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

Please note that dogs must be kept on a lead except in the Exercise Area provided. Please clean up after your dogs – competitors failing to comply will be asked to leave the venue (as per Regulation 27).

THERE IS LIMITED SPACE FOR CARAVANS OR CAMPER VANS ON THE SHOW SITE FOR THE SATURDAY NIGHT. Your fee will be returned if the Site is full. All caravans and camper vans must have means of extinguishing fire and a first aid kit.

Please note that entrance to the Showground will not be permitted until after 4.00 p.m. on the Saturday.

DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE

From M25 Junction 9 follow the A24 to Dorking and then Horsham. At the big roundabout where the A24 meets the A29 take the A29 exit towards Bognor Regis. At Ockley take the right hand turn on the B2126 towards Ewhurst and Cranleigh. Stay on that road through Ewhurst village. This leads onto the B2127. The Showground is along Bookhurst Road, on the right hand side just before you get into Cranleigh village proper.

From Guildford take the A281 towards Horsham. After Smithbrook Kiln take the B2130, a left-hand turn towards Cranleigh. At the main crossroads turn or bear right onto the B2128, which will take you through Cranleigh Village itself. Follow the signs for Ewhurst on the same road, which will lead you to the B2127 Bookhurst Road. The Showground is on the left just as you come out of the village proper.

Welfare of Dogs – a competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with the Kennel Club Regulations for Classification & Registration B. The registration number will be required for each entry.
2. The entry fees are £2.80 per Class (including day membership of Billingshurst Dog Club and postage). NFC Free.
3. Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible for competition. 'Not for competition' entries accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details including their KC/ATC number recorded on the entry form.
4. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
5. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the Show boundaries.
6. Dogs must not wear slip chains, collars or leads when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar, i.e. not attached by a ring.
7. No competitor shall impugn the decisions of the Judge(s).
8. Standard marking will be in accordance with KC Regulations H, Annex B, paragraph 5.
9. The 'Jump' obstacles will be 650 mm high in all large classes, 450 mm high in all medium classes and 350 mm high in all small classes unless stated otherwise in the definition of the classes.
10. Judges at an Agility Test may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the test at which they are judging.
11. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the test if it is:
 - a) a bitch in season
 - b) suffering from an infectious or contagious disease
 - c) interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
 - d) of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e) likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
12. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins and awards up to and including 17th June, 2009 shall be counted when entering for any class. It is the competitor's responsibility to notify the Show Secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog must then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. If there are no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the entry fee.
13. Dogs will be received at any time. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their classes and running order.
14. Billingshurst DTC Committee reserves to itself the right to:
 - a) refuse entries
 - b) appoint another Judge should any scheduled Judge be unable to fulfil their appointment
 - c) accept no responsibility for losses, damages, injuries or errors arising from any cause whatsoever or for exhibitors missing their classes
 - d) alter arrangements as necessary in consultation with the judges should circumstances dictate. Such changes and circumstance surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel club
 - e) defray from received entry fees, such expenses as are necessary to cover the cost of the Show preparations should it be necessary to abandon this Show due to circumstances beyond their control.
15. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except assistance dogs or dogs required for demonstration purposes, or by permission of the general committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
16. Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
17. A dog must at the time of entry for the Competition, be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitors name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered for the purpose of the regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete as the new owner's property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.
18. Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs left in vehicles being found in a distressed condition.
19. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
20. No dog will be allowed in the ring at any time other than when being judged. No practising will be allowed in the ring.
21. Internet entries will be accepted via www.iShowServices.com
22. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
23. Dogs are limited to 3 classes
24. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits
25. A practice ring will be available if space allows
26. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
27. Competitors must clean up after their dogs - those not doing so may be asked to leave the venue.
