It is possible (*and permissible*) that the judge may set the same course for 'Golden Oldies' and 'Capability' classes.

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

(to be run in the order detailed below - see the one ring* and two ring** options)

Please note we usually run only one ring, the agility classes will be run then the jumping classes. In the event of 2 rings being run, the classes will be as follows:- *Ring 1 (Agility) classes 1-4. **Ring 2 (Jumping) class 7, 6, 5 then 8 - you will receive notice in the event of this happening.

- 1* Golden Oldies/Capability Agility
- 5** Golden Oldies/Capability Jumping
- 2* Level One Agility
- 6** Level One Jumping
- 3* Level Two/Three Agility
- 7** Level Two/Three Jumping
- 4* Delinquentz Dodgem/ Time, Fault & Out - same course for all, awarded Golden Oldies/ Capability (Golden Oldies, November & December Shows only), Level One then Level Two/Three (in the event of few entries GO, Capability and Level 1 will be awarded together).
- 8** Flick Flack Challenge/Helter Skelter - same course for all, awarded Golden Oldies/ Capability (Golden Oldies, November & December Shows only), Level One then Level Two/Three (in the event of few entries GO, Capability and Level 1 will be awarded together).

AWARDS

Trophies 1st - 3rd in all Classes - the trophies WILL be 'doggy things'.

Rosettes to at least 3rd in all Classes.

Clear Round Rosettes in all Regular Agility and Jumping Classes - NOT in the Games classes.

Extra Special Clear Round Rosettes in 'Golden Oldie' classes.

DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

J1 M18. Follow signs for Bawtry/Maltby down to first roundabout. Turn around as though you are going to go back to the motorway. There is a Douglas Paul 4 x 4 garage on the LHS, turn left here. This is Cumwell Lane. Follow this road right to the end, you will pass a RHT (Flash Lane) and fishing ponds on your right. As you approach the junction you will see the venue on the right hand side. At the junction, where EMC garage is, turn right. Pass the Consort Suite Hotel, go over the motorway bridge and turn right up the first drive (there is a triangular warning road sign, absolutely, totally and utterly bang opposite the drive you need). If you get to the bus stop on either side of the road, you have gone too far. As you turn into the drive, please take a RHT turn (takes you in front of the bungalow). The venue is then immediately in front of you.

Please respect that the house is a private residence and do not park anywhere near the bottom of the drive, there is enough parking for all near the rings. Please also park where directed. **Thank you.**

CLASSES AVAILABLE FOR ALL HEIGHTS AND LEVEL OF DOGS INCLUDING DOGS 15 MONTHS OF AGE AND OVER

JUMP HEIGHTS

8" for 'Tinies' - e.g Papillon, Teacup JRT, Toy Poodle (if you have a 'Tiny' but compete at KC we would request that you enter 12").

12" for dogs who qualify for Kennel Club 'Small' classes.
17" for dogs who qualify for Kennel Club 'Medium' classes.

20" for dogs who fall into the 'Small/Large dogs' category and would have to jump 26" at Kennel Club shows (please note if you do compete at KC shows as a large on a regular basis then you cannot enter this height) - these dogs should stand in between 17" and 20" at the shoulder.

Any dog standing higher than this will jump 24".

The ONLY exception to this are the 'Golden Oldie' and the 'Capability' classes: where the jump height will be set at the owners discretion: but will be no higher than 17".

'Golden Oldies' may enter the Agility and Jumping classes only with the exception of the Christmas Show when they may enter the Games classes.

Dogs must be at least 15 months of age to compete at any of the shows.



GOLDEN OLDIE & CAPABILITY

The 'Golden Oldie' classes are for dogs at least 8 years of age or over. They must not compete at any other level ('Veteran' and 'Any Size' classes excepted) at any other show. Dogs 8 years of age or over may continue to compete in their respective level should the handler feel they are able. These classes have no set course time nor contain weaves or, in the event of Agility classes, a see saw. Dogs may enter Agility or Jumping classes only, the exception being the November and December Shows when dogs may enter the Games classes. See regulations regarding jump height.

The 'Capability' classes are for dogs who do not compete at their specified jump height and are too young to be eligible for the 'Golden Oldie' classes. The classes are also for baby dogs of 15 MONTHS up to 18 months, as a 'beginner' experience. See regulations regarding jump height. Again, there will be no set course time, weaves or see saw.

GUNDOG TROPHY (Teal and Albie)

Dedicated to Teal and her son Albie who, as many of you know were owned by Dragon herself. Both were fantastic Black Labradors. This will be awarded to the highest placed Gun Dog throughout the summer series of shows and will be presented on the last day of our Finals Weekend in July. **PLEASE MARK ON THE ENTRY FORM IF YOU HAVE A GUN DOG** (open to all breeds of Gundog and gundog crosses e.g Springer x Lab (Springador) or Springer x Cocker(Sprocker)).

The winner of this award will receive an engraved shield to hold on to until the last show of the 2010 series and a keep sake trophy and rosette. There will be trophies to 3rd and rosettes to at least 5th.

GOLDEN OLDIES LEAGUE

The trophy has been sponsored by 'Delinquent Dogz' member, Maxine Segall and is in memory of 'Kali' - her very precious and loving little Collie girl. Again the trophy will be awarded on the last day of our Finals Weekend in July. Maxine will also award rosettes 1 - 3.

FINALS WEEKEND

We are, for the first time during our 2009 series of shows, offering Levels Tables with points accrued going towards qualifying for our Finals weekend. Points are awarded in Agility and Jumping classes (not the Games classes) as follows:

20 points 1st place, 15 points 2nd place, 10 points 3rd place, 5 points 4th place onwards (5th, 6th, 7th etc will all get 5 points where rosettes are awarded).

Clear round in Agility classes = 2 points.
Clear round in Jumping classes = 1 point.

LEVELS

'Capability' classes are intended for:- handlers and dogs totally new to competition (until you get the confidence to enter KC shows), handlers with dogs 'not capable' of doing their regulation height (for instance jumping 26" at Kennel Club) and handlers with dogs from the age of 15 months to 18 months of age. 'Capability' classes offer a competition environment minus the weaves or see saw. For those who start their Delinquent Dogz experience in 'Capability' classes, you may stay in this level until:- A) you feel you are ready to move up to 'Level One', B) We feel you are ready to move up to 'Level One' (usually by virtue of wins gained) this decision is always reached in consultation with you, C) the dog reaches 18 months of age or D) until you enter KC shows. You cannot switch between 'Capability' and 'Level One' at will, unless you have a dog recovering from injury.

'Level One' classes are aimed at Kennel Club Grades 1, 2 and 3 and may contain the see saw and weaves. For the more experienced handler we offer the opportunity for any 'newbie' dog who has to compete at KC Grade 3 by virtue of another dog's win to compete with DD at 'Level One'.

Any dog competing at Grade 4 or 5 (Kennel Club) should enter 'Level Two' classes. Grade 6 & 7 (Kennel Club) dogs should enter DD 'Level Three'. We reserve the right to combine the classes for Level Two and Three dogs.

CLASSES

'Flick Flack Challenge' - An open, flowing Jumping course which will contain a series of Flick Flacks. This course will not contain weaves as 'Capability' dogs will be competing in this class.

'Delinquentz Dodgem' - This will be an Agility course which will contain at least one bit of contact equipment (but not the see saw as 'Capability' dogs will be competing in this class). In addition this class will contain 'traps' of tunnels - which you must AVOID - for every tunnel taken you will accrue an additional second on your final time.

'Helter Skelter' - An open flowing Jumping course which will run either from the centre of the ring out or edge of the ring in.

'Time, Fault and Out' - An Agility course which should contain the A Frame and Dog Walk (weather permitting). The judge will set a course time during their briefing. The object of this class is to complete as many obstacles as you can during the course time your judge gives. You carry on until you either, fault on the course or reach the time the judge decrees. Most obstacles in the fastest time wins!!
