ELIGIBILITY OF CLASSES

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). **In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.**

Grade 1 Elementary	For owners, handlers or dogs, which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows. <i>N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.</i>
Grade 2 (Starters)	Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7, and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. <i>N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.</i>
Grade 3 (Graduate)	Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.
Grade 4 (Novice)	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.
Grade 5 Intermediate	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.
Grade 6 (Senior)	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.
Grade 7 (Advanced)	Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.
Veteran	For dogs aged nine years or over on the day of the show and not entered in any other class. There will be no tyre in this class. The hurdle height will be 35cm.

AWARDS

Rosettes in all classes to 10% of entries with clear round rosettes to unplaced clear rounds in all classes.

Trophies to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all classes

Proposed order of judging: This will be sent out with the running orders

Dogs in Hot Cars

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

PLEASE NOTE:

In accordance with KC rules, large dogs who have not competed before 1st January 2006 & ALL Small & medium dogs must have **been officially measured** before competing at a KC licensed Agility show.

Dogs can only be entered in one size category (ie large, medium or small)

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

Open to dogs having qualified to compete at grade 7 to consist of 2 qualifying rounds of Standard Kennel club Classes, 1 Agility Class and 1 Jumping Class and a final round of Agility to be held at the same Show.

Points will be awarded for placings in the Agility round and Jumping round. 1st place = 1 point, 2nd place = 2 points etc to the final placed dog, eliminated dogs excepted.

The top 50% of the entry up to a maximum of 20 dogs with the lowest accumulated total will be eligible to compete in the final round. Elimination in either of the qualifying rounds will exclude the dog from competition in the final round. In the event of a tie for the last place the time/faults will be taken into account for both qualifying rounds to determine the last qualifying place.

The calculation to decide the equal place is:-

(1) The dog with the least course faults in both the Agility and Jumping rounds. In the event that these dogs are still equal,
(2) The dog with the fastest combined time qualifies.

Running Orders: A draw for the running order of the Agility and Jumping Rounds will be made prior to the show, which must be strictly adhered to. The relevant competitors will be notified before the day of the show.

CRUFTS Singles Agility Competition

These competitions will be scheduled as a combined class for grades 6 & 7 for all height categories. There will be a separate qualifying competition for each height category. There will be 12 separate heats for each height category, (small, medium, large) held at Kennel Club licensed shows, throughout the country.

The first 10 placed dogs in each heat will have the following points awarded:

1st place = 10 points, 2nd place = 9 points etc. down to 10th place = 1 point.

In the event of awards not going down to 10th place the Show Secretary will record the top ten places excluding eliminated dogs.

Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat. Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the final.

The 16 large dogs with the highest accumulation of points will be invited to compete in the CRUFTS Singles Large Agility Final at CRUFTS 2010.

The European Open Ranking Events 2009 (Final 2010) (Classes 15,19 and 24)

The classes will be combined Grades 6 and 7 Agility Classes.

The first 10 placed dogs in each heat will have the following points awarded:

1st place = 10 points, 2nd place = 9 points etc. down to 10th place = 1 point.

In the event of awards not going down to 10th place the Show Secretary will record the top ten places excluding eliminated dogs.

Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat.

Only English handlers and dogs placed in the top ten will score points based on their position in the top ten. e.g. if a handler from another nation is in the top ten, their points are not taken by an English handler. The other home nations will run their own system of qualifying.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/ATC number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry Fees. Championship Classes £8 Standard Classes £2.60 (Helping Gillingham (Dorset) DTS members £1.)
3. Prize money - There will be no prize money at this show.
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible to compete for Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
6. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form including Kennel Club Number.
7. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
8. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
10. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
12. There are no sponsors.
13. Kennel Club Standard marking will apply.
14. The Height limit for dogs.
 - a. Large Dogs - For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
 - b. Medium Dogs - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
 - c. Small Dogs - For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
15. Judges at an Agility Test may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Test at which they are judging.
16. Withdrawal of dogs from Test. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is:-
 - a) A bitch which is in season.
 - b) Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
17. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition shall be counted when entering for any classes. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class/es for the next grade. The dog will be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. **The Secretary to be notified in writing, with a SAE for acknowledgment or the dog will not be permitted to compete.**
18. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
19. A dog must at the time of entry for the Competition be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitors' name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be

considered for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete as the new owners' property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form. NFC dogs must also be registered with the Kennel Club.

20. Food, training aids or toys shall not be taken into the ring.
21. Ballot for Championship Class Running Orders
 - a. Agility Round and Jumping Round - A draw for the running order of the Agility and Jumping Rounds must be made prior to the show. The relevant competitors must be notified before the day of the show. The dogs must run in the order in which they are drawn.
 - b. Final Agility Round - Dogs to run in reverse order to their combined placings at the end of the first two rounds.
22. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
24. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
25. Animals in Event. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.

However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times
26. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
27. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
28. A practice ring will be available if space allows.
29. Please clear up after your dog or the Show Manager will ask you to leave the showground.
30. In the event of abandonment of the Show through circumstances beyond the control of the Committee, expenses may be defrayed from the entry fees to cover the cost of the preparations for the show.
31. All dogs will be entered at this show at their owner's risk Gillingham Agility Society and Turnpike Showground cannot be held responsible for loss, damage or injury howsoever caused to dogs, persons or property.
32. There will be no practising in the Ring during or after the show. A briefing will be held prior to the start of each class and competitors will be allowed to walk the course without their dogs.
33. Internet entries will be received via www.ishowservices.com
39. Rosettes should be collected on the day. Uncollected rosettes will not be sent on.
40. **DOGS SHOULD BE ON A LEAD, OR BEHIND A SECURE BARRIER AT ALL TIMES, EXCEPT WHEN COMPETING OR IN THE MARKED EXERCISE AREAS.**
41. **In case of cancellation of the show within 7 days of the show date, notification will be sent to the relevant web sites where possible and notified to the iSS Show Hotline 07532 11 11 57. It will be the competitor's responsibility to check with the Hotline and/or the Web sites, if continuation of the show is in doubt.**

Welfare of Dogs

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Competitors are reminded of the suffering that can be caused when dogs are left in cars on sunny days. Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs being found in a distressed condition. A Site Manager will be appointed to police the parking area.

GILLINGHAM (Dorset) DTS is a small club and will need all the help it can get to run the show. All entries are accepted on the understanding that all competitors will help at sometime during the show. Those competitors who help for 4 hours or more a day will be given a breakfast or lunch voucher, a gift and preferential parking and camping. Please mark your entry form and camping form if you are willing to work for 4 hours or more. Judges will be offered free camping plus free runs for up to two dogs on the day they are not judging.

Please remember that if your dog wins out before the cut off date, it is your responsibility to notify the secretary in writing, at least 14 days before the show, with a SAE for acknowledgement, or your dog will not be permitted to run.

SITE INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: The showground gates are locked each night at 11pm for security reasons.
Competitors will be given the number for the lock on arrival.

CAMPING

- Camping is only on the designated site and is LIMITED. Cost of camping is £20 per unit Friday to Sunday night inclusive or part thereof. Please send a separate cheque (Made out to Gillingham (Dorset) DTS) for camping to **Tony Griffin**.
- Camping admissions are ONLY from 12 noon on Friday 11th September 2009 and everyone MUST leave the campsite by 2 pm Monday 14th September 2009.
- **NO CAMPING WILL ACCEPTED WITHOUT A COMPLETED CAMPING FORM**
- We are unable to reserve spaces for Clubs/Individuals.
- If you arrive after 8.30 pm the Camping Stewards will be off duty so please camp where indicated overnight and you will be moved to the main campsite in the morning.
- The size of pitch includes one caravan and awning or tent and one vehicle. Please advise as to what overnight accommodation you will be using so we can endeavour to site you appropriately.
- For Health & Safety reasons please park according to instructions given.
- Roadways and accesses MUST be kept clear.
- Each camping unit MUST HAVE an appropriate fire extinguisher and a bucket of water outside.
- The camping form and the entry form must be sent to **different addresses** given on each form.

Generators: These must not be used between 10pm and 8am in consideration of your neighbours.

Chemical Toilets must only be emptied where indicated. **DO NOT** empty chemical toilets in the show toilets or wash them out at the fresh water standpipes. **No Nappies or other solid waste in the sanitary traps or show toilets please.**

Water is available at various standpipes around the site. Sorry, but no showers will be available.

Rubbish. Please ensure that rubbish of any description is put into the skips and bins provided.

Barbeques. Please note that ONLY gas barbecues are allowed on site.

Exercise Area -The exercise area will be clearly marked. A maximum of two dogs per handler only permitted off lead in the exercise area. Please be aware of any sheep in adjoining fields. The rest of the showground and public area is on leads only, and you must 'pick up' everywhere. Poo bags MUST be deposited in the bins provided. You will be asked to leave the showground if you do not pick up after your dog(s).

Refreshments and Trade Stands: We will have a variety of refreshment vans on site and there are several good public houses in the area. There are supermarkets close by in Gillingham (Waitrose and Somerfields) and in Shaftesbury (Tesco). There will also be a variety of trade stands.

TURNPIKE SHOWGROUND, MOTCOMBE, Nr GILLINGHAM, DORSET SP7 9PN

This form must be used by one person only (or partnership) Any bank charges incurred as a result of incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques will be passed on to the exhibitor concerned. Incorrectly completed entry forms will be returned. Writing must be in INK or INDELIBLE PENCIL. Use one line only for each dog and all details recorded with the Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of the Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by the Kennel Club. A dog must at the time of entry for the competition, be registered as required by Kennel Club Rules and Regulations in the competitor's name (or registration or transfer applied for).
