## **STANDARD CLASSES**

**Only First prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade).**

### **Grade 1 (Elementary)**

**For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.**

### **Grade 2 (Starters)**

**For owners, handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.**

### **Grade 3 (Graduate)**

**Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6, or 7.**

### **Grade 4 (Novice)**

**Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7**

### **Grade 5 (Intermediate)**

**Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.**

### **Grade 6 (Senior)**

**Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.**

### **Grade 7 (Advanced)**

**Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.**

### **Special Classes - Juniors**

**Open to large, medium and small dogs. Dogs may only be entered in one Junior classification. Entry is limited to two dogs per handler. Under 12 years: Open to Handlers under 12 years old on the day of the class of 2008. Over 12 years: Open to Handlers over 12 years old and 18 years and under on the day of the class.**

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The Registration number will be required for each entry.
2. The entry fee is £2.25 per dog per class
3. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests.
4. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
5. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
6. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
7. Dogs must not wear slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
8. Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
9. The Committee reserves the right to appoint an additional judge if they consider this necessary.
10. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judges.
11. Marking - standard marking will apply according to Kennel Club regulations H1 (Annex B).
12. The height of jumps will be 650mm (2ft 1.6ins) in all classes except Small Classes, when the height will be 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and in Medium Classes, when the height will be 450mm (1ft 5.7ins).
13. Judges at an Agility Test may not enter for competition a dog, which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Test at which they are judging.
14. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order.
15. Handlers working more than one dog in a Class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
16. No entries will be accepted without correct entry fees and all exhibits are entered at their own risk.
17. No responsibility will be accepted for loss, damage or whatever to persons, dogs or property at this Show.
18. Withdrawal of dogs from test - a dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is:
  - a. A bitch, which is in season
  - b. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any other person or animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
19. No dog suffering from any infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing this Regulation will be liable to be fined and / or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42. No such dog may be present within the boundaries of the Show.
20. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog should then be moved in to the appropriate class(es) for next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at a lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade, the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant fees.
21. Should circumstances so dictate, the society, in consultation with the judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
22. In the event of the abandonment of the Show through circumstances beyond their control, the Committee may defray any expenses incurred in preparation, from entry fees.
23. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dog's aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
24. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
25. Dogs will be received at any time. However, competitors arriving after the show opens may not be accepted for classes if they have missed their allotted running order.
26. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor, or his authorised agent, in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. The appropriate fees must accompany entry forms.
27. In the event of a dispute all placed small/medium dogs will be measured at the judges' discretion.
28. Entry fees will not be refunded after closing date. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure the correct fees are enclosed, no refunds for overpayments permitted. Entries will be returned in the case of cheques being unacceptable to the bank.
29. Any Prize not collected at the show will not be posted unless a SAE is sent with a request.
30. It is the responsibility of individual handlers to ensure that they are entered in the correct grade.
31. Junior: Under 12 years: Open to Handlers under 12 years old on the day of the class. Over 12 years: Open to Handlers over 12 years old and 18 years and under on the day of the class.

**Rosettes to minimum of 10% of class entries or 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> which ever is the larger.**

**Trophies: 1st in all Graded Classes, 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in all Combined Classes**

### **Perennial Trophies:**

**Best Senior in Show: “Mystic Lady Senior Shield”** kindly donated by Alan Gordon. Points will be awarded for dog in Grades 6 & 7 in classes 1,6,14,21,28,29,44,52 as follows: 1st place – 20 points, 2nd place – 15points, 3rd place – 10 points, 4th place – 6pts, 5th place – 4pts, 6th place – 2pts and 7<sup>th</sup> place – 1pt. Dog with the highest points will be deemed the winner. In the event of a tie, the dog with the greater number of senior placings will win. If a tie continues the dog with the most senior agility placings will win. If a tie continues the dog with the least accumulated course times in senior agility wins. At this final elimination stage, should the tied dogs not have any agility placings then the dog with the fastest jumping placing wins.

**Best ABC Large Grade 2 Class 2: “Zakstone Jolly Jupiter Shield”** kindly donated by Pamela Pickard will be presented to the highest placed large ABC dog Grade 2 in Class 2.

**Best GCDAC Large Dog in Show: “Ardene House Agility Cup”** kindly donated by Ardene House Veterinary Practice. Points will be awarded to Granite City D.A.C. dogs in classes 1,2,3,6,9,14,21,24,27,28,29,32,35,44,49,52 as follows: 15pts for 1<sup>st</sup> place down to 1pt for 15<sup>th</sup> place for classes stated above. Only rosette places are points indexed linked. Dog with the highest points will be the winner. In the event of a tie the dog with the greater number of placings in relevant classes will win. If a tie still exists the trophy will be shared.

**Best GCDAC Small /Medium Dog in Show: “Technip - Coflexip Agility Cup”** kindly donated by Technip - Coflexip. Points will be awarded to Granite City D.A.C. dogs in classes: 5,8,11,13,18,19,23,26,30,33,36,39,40,45 small dogs, and 4,7,10,12,17,20,22,25,31,34,37,38,41,46,48,51 medium dogs as follows: 15pts for 1st place down to 1pt for 15th place for classes stated above. Only rosette places are points indexed linked. Dog with the highest points will be the winner. In the event of a tie the dog with the greater number of placings in relevant classes will win. If a tie still exists the trophy will be shared.

## ELIGIBILITY OF CLASSES AND CONDITIONS

This classification should apply to competitions for large, medium and small dogs. In the following definitions of classes First Prize or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club Open licensed Open Agility Shows (i.e. Limited Agility Shows, special classes and invitation events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round will count towards grade progression. Agility classes to include contact points and Jumping classes where there are not contact obstacles. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

**CLASS STRUCTURE.** A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for one or more consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

**PROGRESSION.** Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins at that grade, except that progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes.

Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

**POINTS PROGRESSION.** At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 5 by winning 75 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme, Regulation K3.c refers, except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however, once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

Grade 1 (Elementary) – Existing Elementary dogs.

Grade 2 (Starters) – Existing Starter dogs.

Grade 3 (Graduate) – Existing Novice dogs that have not gained a top 10 place in Novice or above during 2006.

Grade 4 (Novice) – Existing Novice dogs that have been placed 6th to 10th in Novice or above during 2006.

Grade 5 (Intermediate) – Existing Novice dogs that have gained a top 5 place in Novice or above during 2006.

Grade 6 (Senior) – Existing Senior dogs.

Grade 7 (Advanced) – Existing Advanced dogs.

Existing wins gained up to 31/12/06 in Intermediate, Senior and Open Classes can be carried forward for progression to Grade 7.

Dogs that achieved a top 10 place prior to 2006 in Novice or above (but not in 2006) have the option, at the beginning of 2007, of competing in the grade achieved, as above, OR dropping down one grade to Grade 3 or 4 (accordingly).

**MEASUREMENT:** In accordance with Kennel Club rules, Large dogs which have not competed before 1st January 2006 and ALL Small and Medium dogs must have been officially measured before competing at a Kennel Club licensed agility show. Record books or proof of measurement must be available on request.

Dogs can only enter the class for which they are eligible i.e. Small, Medium or Large.

Dogs eligible to compete in competitions for Small dogs are those measuring 35cms or under at the withers.

Dogs eligible to compete in competitions for Medium dogs are those measuring over 35cms and 43cms or under at the withers.

Dogs eligible to compete in competitions for Large dogs are those measuring over 43cms at the withers.

**JUNIORS:** Open to large, medium and small dogs. Dogs may only be entered in one junior classification. Entry is limited to two dogs per handler. Under 12 years: Open to Handlers under 12 years old on the 27<sup>th</sup> July of 2009. Over 12 years: Open to Handlers over 12 years old and 18 years and under on the 27<sup>th</sup> of July 2009.

**PARKING** Day visitors should park in the designated area.  
(Please keep vehicles on the track indicated to reduce damage to grass).

### **CAMPING - Campers must abide by the following rules:**

1. The camping area available from 4.00pm on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2009.
2. The camping area must be vacated by 10.30am on Monday the 28<sup>th</sup> July 2009.
3. All units must carry suitable fire extinguishers and first aid facilities (Kennel Club Health & Safety Guidelines annex A" G) and have a bucket of water sited outside, at the front of the unit.
4. Dogs must be kept on a lead in the camping area.
5. Further guidelines may be issued on arrival at camping area.
6. No Disposable Barbeques must be used

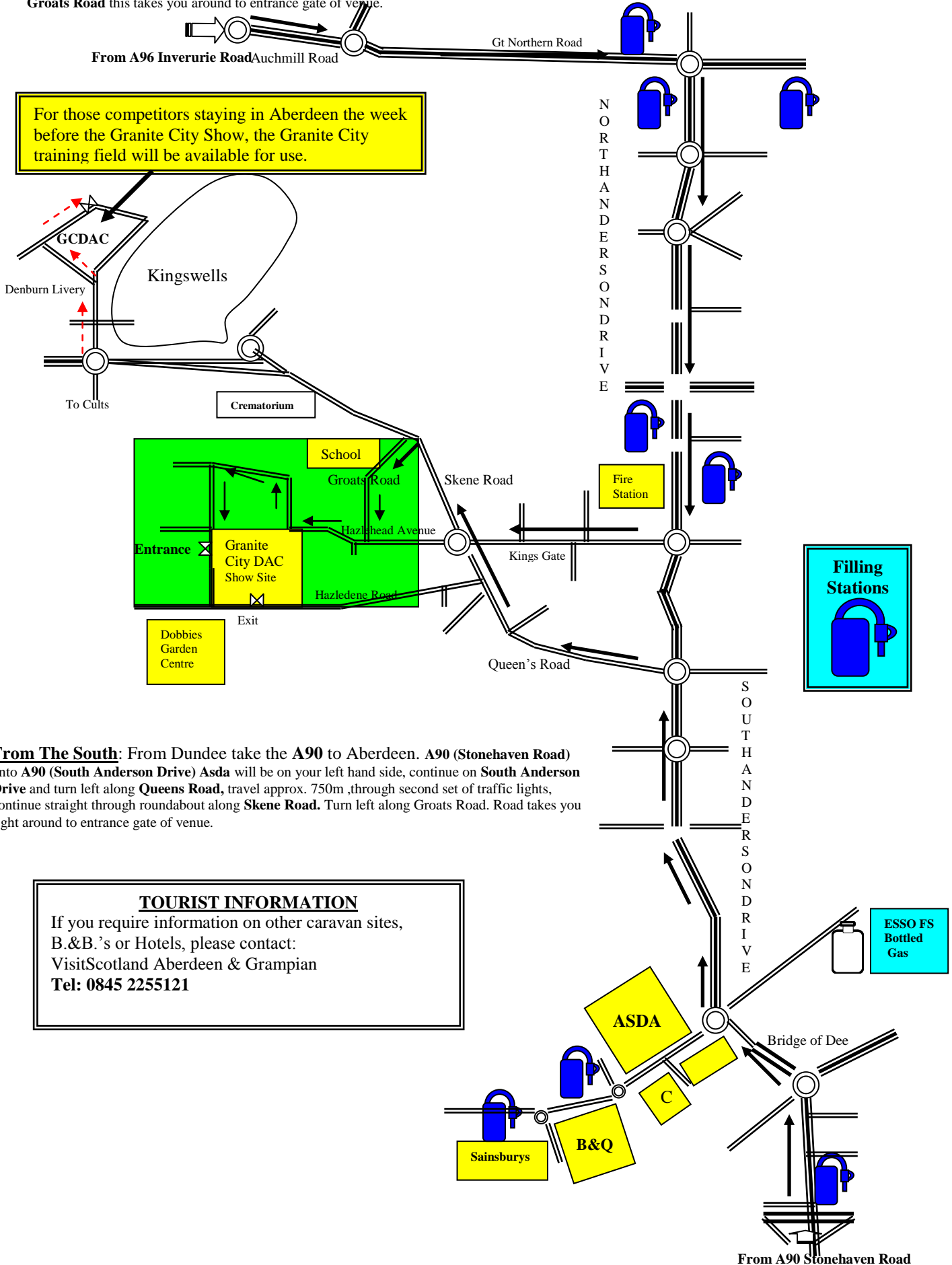

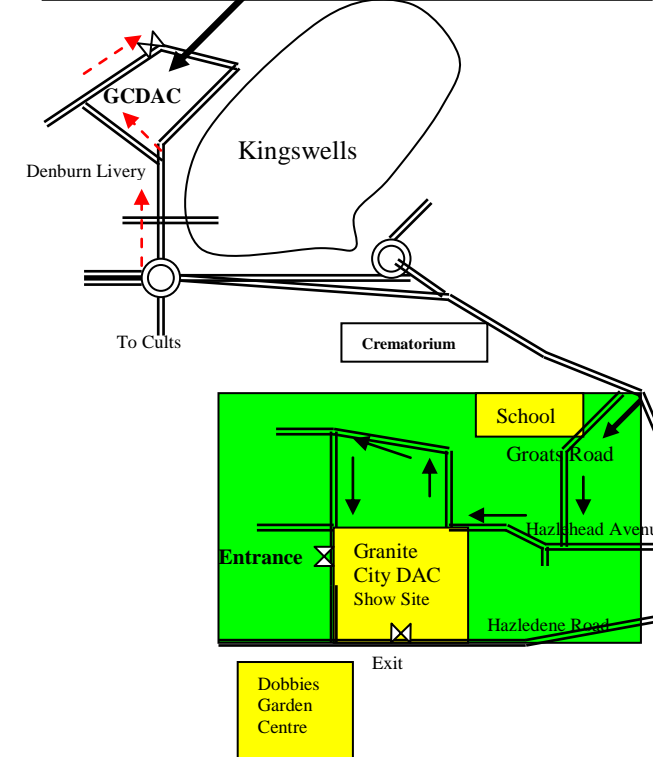
# DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

For those competitors staying in Aberdeen the week before the Granite City Show, the Granite City training field will be available for use.



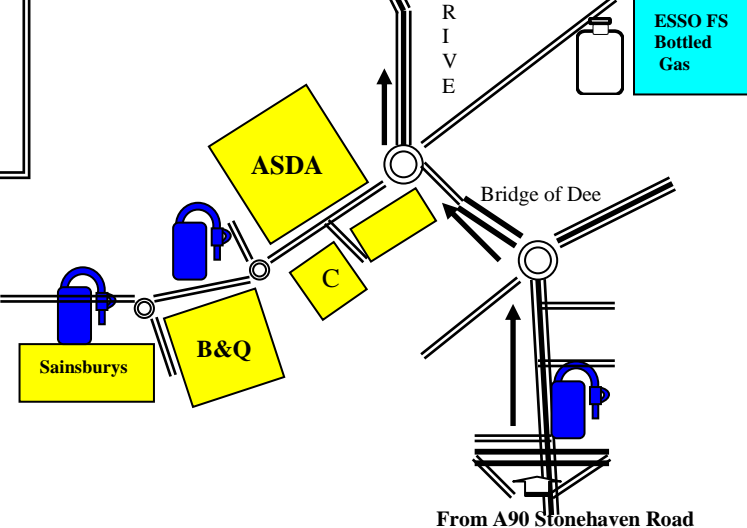
