CLASSIFICATIONS

Grade 1 For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an agility class or 3 first places in Jumping Classes at a licenced agility a licensed Agility shows.

Grade 2 For dogs, handlers or owners which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at grade 2 at K.C. licenced agility shows or elected to progress on points from grade 1

Grade 3 Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from grade 2 at licenced Kennel Club agility shows and dogs not eligible for grade 4,5,6 or7

Grade 4 Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at grade 3 or elected to progress on points from grade3 at K.C. licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for grades 5,6or7.

Grade 5 Open to dogs having won a first place in an agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at grade 4 or elected to progression points from grade 4 at K.C. licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for grades 6 or 7

Grade 6 Open to all dogs which have gained a first place in an agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at Grade 5 at K.C. licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for grade 7

Grade 7 Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at grade 6 at K.C. licensed Agility shows,2 first places must be gained in Agility (not jumping)

Special Mixi Pairs Open to any combination of sizes of poodle. Agility and jumping. Enter your dog and find a partner in the queue.

A RUNNING ORDER MAY BE DRAWN IN ADVANCE DEPENDING ON ENTRIES

The Ring Size will be non standard and may be indoors or outdoors depending on the weather.

AWARDS

All classes except pairs – will be run with separate placings to large, medium and small dogs. Trophies to at least 1st and 2nd rosettes 1st to 5th. Specials for best unplaced grades 1,2, 3,

Pairs – Rosettes 1st to 5th with trophies for 1st and 2nd

Rosettes to all unplaced clear rounds in all classes.

Dogs in Hot Cars

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs must, at the time of entry for the competition, be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitors' name (or registration applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the Directors and the Secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered as the competitor for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete as the new owner's property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the competition and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original form.
2. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete Number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete Number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for competition at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Tests.
- 4 No animal(s) other than one(s) officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except a registered guide dog for the blind or hearing dog for the deaf, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.
5. NFC Dogs aged four calendar months or over will be accepted. Dogs must be Kennel Club Registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
6. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 7 days before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e.5 September 2009.
7. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden. No bitch in season will be allowed to compete.
8. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Test if it is:
 - a) A bitch in season
 - b) Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease. (No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period 21 days prior to competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
 - c) Interfering with the safety or chances of winning of an opponent
 - d) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal
 - e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing
9. No person shall carry punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show
- 10 Should a Judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge.
- 11 A Judge at an Agility show may not enter for competition a dog that is recorded in their ownership or part ownership or handle a dog at a show at which they are judging.
- 12 No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.

13 Standard marking as set out in Kennel Club Regulations H (1)(A) will apply to all scheduled classes.

14 Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.

15. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to the dog in the ring. No toys or training implements allowed in the ring.

16 No dog will be allowed in any competition ring at any time other than when being judged. No practicing will be allowed in the rings (other than a ring specifically designated as a practice ring and only for the period of time that the ring is so designated).

17. Height limit for dogs- Large Dogs Those measuring over 430mm(1ft 5ins) at the withers: Medium dogs. Those measuring over 350mm(1ft1.75ins) & 430mm(1ft 5ins) or under at the withers: Small dogs. Those measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers

18. The height of the jumps will be a maximum of 65cm for large dogs 45cm for medium dogs and 35cm for small dogs.

19. All dogs are entered at this Show at the owners risk and whilst the Committee will take every reasonable care, it shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury, howsoever caused to dogs, people or property at the Show.

20. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.

21. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judge(s), may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to The Kennel Club.

22. In the event of abandonment of the Show through circumstances beyond the control of the Society, the Committee reserves the right to defray such expenses as appropriate from the entry fees so as to cover the cost of Show preparations.

24. Small and medium dogs must have been measured and have their record books available if required.

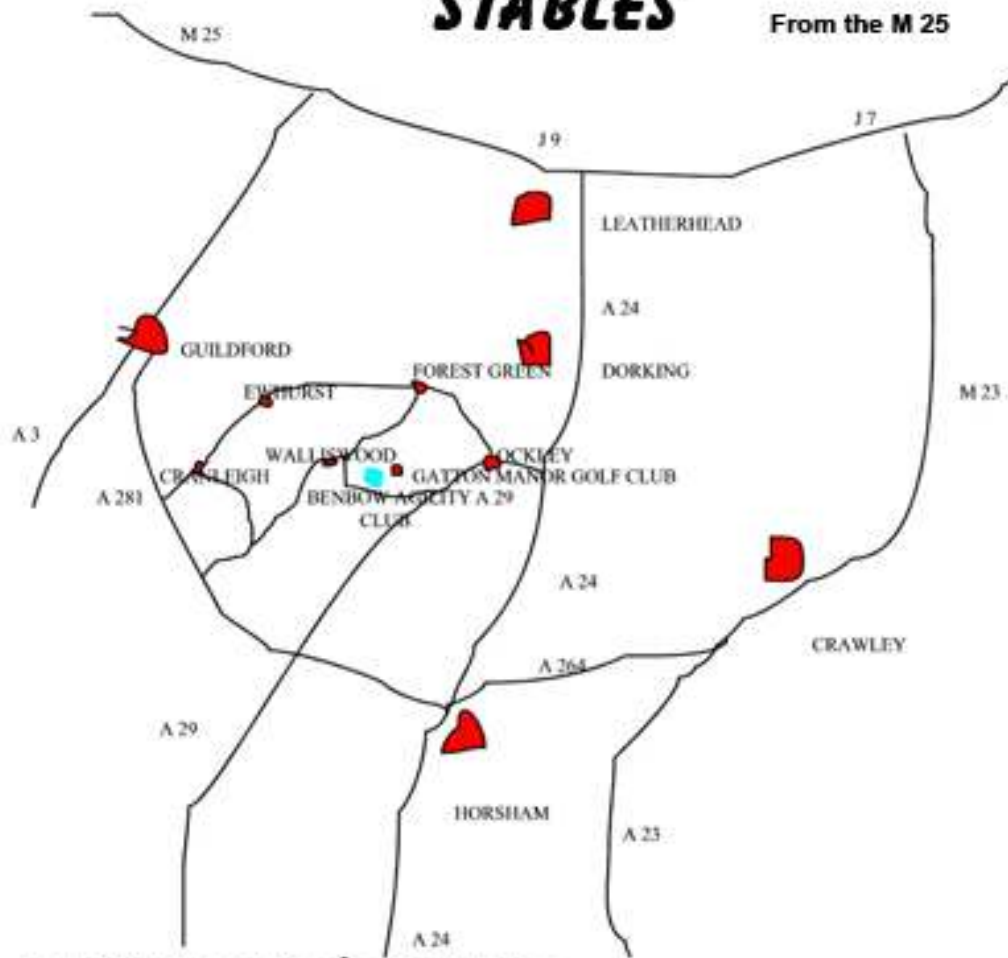
25. Large dogs that hadn't competed before 01/01/06 must have been measured & have their record books available if required.

26 Organisers reserve the right to eject any person(s) from the show/showground for actions deemed detrimental to the show

DIRECTIONS TO BENBOW STABLES

From the M 25



Leave M25 at J9 and take the A24 towards Dorking. Follow the A24 all the way to Dorking. Continue on the A24 towards Horsham through South Holmwood and Beare Green. At the roundabout take the exit for Ockley A29. After 3.2 miles turn right into Cathill Lane (signposted Gattin Manor). At the end of the lane turn left into Standon Lane. Continue over the little bridge past left turn to Oakwood Church and entrance to Gattin Manor. At left hand bend with house facing turn right (Agility Sign). At the end of the houses on the right turn right into Benbow Stables (Agility Sign). At the far end of the drive there is an electronically operated gate, press the button on the post to open gate and park.
