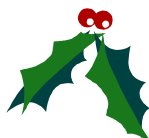

Classification:

Large: see Regulation 16a

Medium: see Regulation 16b

Small: see Regulation 16c

Special Any Size Jumping – for dogs not entered in any other class, jump heights as per Regulation 15.



REGULATIONS



1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations B (Classification and Registration). The registration number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry Fees £2.70 per dog per class (RDTC members £1).
3. There is no prize money.
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Competition are not eligible for Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.
6. Not for Competition entries free and will be accepted for dogs aged 4 calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
7. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is prohibited.
8. No bitch in season is allowed to compete or be brought to the Show or its environs.
9. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the environs of the Show, which includes the car park and exercise area.
10. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
11. Should a Judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
12. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
13. There are no sponsors for the show.
14. Kennel Club Standard Marking Regulations apply – a copy of which is available on request.
15. The height of the jump obstacles will be 650mm (2'1.6") for Classes 1,2, 450(1'5.7") for Classes 3,4 and 350mm (1'1.75") for Classes 5,6. For Class 7 height of jumps will be 350mm for large dogs and 250mm for medium and small dogs and there will be no weaves.
16. The height limit for dogs
17.
 - a. Large Dogs – for dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5 inches) at the withers
 - b. Medium Dogs – for dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75inches) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5inches) or under at the withers.
 - c. Small Dogs – for dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75inches) or under at the withers.
18. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging.
19. A dog shall be withdrawn and removed from the Show if it is:
 - a. a bitch which is in season
 - b. suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease
 - c. interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
 - d. of such a temperament or is so much out of hand to be a danger to the safety of any person or animal
 - e. likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
20. KC Specimen Schedule Reg. 22 does not apply.
21. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be available for their class and running order. Dogs will be received, at the judge's discretion, until the management closes the class.
22. Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
23. Should circumstances dictate, the Club, in consultation with the Judges, may alter the arrangements as necessary – such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
24. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition (17 November) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog should then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.

25. KC Specimen Schedule Reg. 25 does not apply.
26. A dog must at the time of entry for the Competition be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitors' name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.
27. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
26. A separate application for entry must be made by each owner and acceptance of the entry declaration must be given in accordance with the provisions specified thereon – whether in writing or via the internet. Entries cannot be accepted without the appropriate fees or acceptance of the entry declaration. Incorrect entries will be returned
27. No Dogs suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Role A42.
28. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. Precincts of the event are the Riding School Buildings.
29. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a KC Authority to Compete number before entry to the Show/Event can be made. All overseas entries without an ATC number will be returned to the competitor.
30. All dogs will be entered in the Show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken the Committee will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury, however caused, to dogs, persons or property whilst at the Show.
31. If circumstances make it necessary that the Competition is cancelled Rugby DTC reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fees received.
32. The owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control, i.e. held on a lead, whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches, except whilst competing or on the exercise area.

Directions

From North and South on M42, Leave at Junction 4; on Roundabout take A3400 exit (Henley); take first left turn (narrow/winding) then left, or left at first roundabout, onto Four Ashes Road; Riding School is on the left after ¾ mile from the roundabout approximately 3/4 mile from the roundabout

This form must be used by one person only (or partnership). Writing MUST BE IN INK OR INDELIBLE PENCIL. Use one line only for each dog. The name of the dog and all details as recorded with the Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made, the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of The Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at The Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Kennel Club. Dogs under 18 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Any bank charges incurred through incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques will be passed on to the owner concerned. The Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC Number) for dogs resident outside of the UK must be stated or the entry will be returned. PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.
