Eligibility & Schedule of Classes

In accordance with Kennel Club Rules, all dogs must have been officially measured before competing at a Kennel Club licensed agility show for the first time.

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade) In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

GRADE 1 (Elementary)

For owners, handlers or dogs, which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2 (Starters)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7, and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 3 (Graduate)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 (Novice)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 (Intermediate)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 (Senior)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 (Advanced)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

Junior Jumping – Will be split into two age groups, those aged under 12 years on the day of the show, and those aged 12 years but under 18 years on the day of the show.

Veterans – Open to dogs aged 9 years and over and not entered in any other class.

Any Size - Open to dogs not entered in any other class. *This is intended as a non-competitive fun run for dogs and only Clear Round rosettes will be awarded, no placed rosettes or trophies.*

Gillian Southern-Rumble trophy to be awarded to the highest placed Jack Russell/Jack Russell cross in Class 56 in memory of Gillian Southern-Rumble who sadly died from cancer. Gilly loved her Jack Russells and ran Rags and Kizzy. Her favorite show was Thames. Please note it is the responsibility of the competitor to notify the "pad" person if they are eligible for this award.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS

Open to dogs having qualified to compete at Grade 7 to consist of 2 qualifying rounds of Standard Kennel club Classes, 1 Agility Class and 1 Jumping Class and a final round of Agility to be held at the same Show.

Points will be awarded for placings in the Agility round and Jumping round. 1st place = 1 point, 2nd place = 2 points etc to the final placed dog, eliminated dogs excepted.

The top 50% of the entry up to a maximum of 20 dogs with the lowest accumulated total will be eligible to compete in the final round. Elimination in either of the qualifying rounds will exclude the dog from competition in the final round.

In the event of a tie for the last place the time/faults will be taken into account for both qualifying rounds to determine the last qualifying place. The calculation to decide the equal place is:-

- (1) The dog with the least course faults in both the Agility and Jumping rounds. In the event that these dogs are still equal,
- (2) The dog with the fastest combined time qualifies.

Running Orders: A draw for the running order of the Agility and Jumping Rounds will be made prior to the show, which must be strictly adhered to. The relevant competitors will be notified before the day of the show.

CRUFTS Singles Agility Competition

These competitions will be scheduled as a combined class for grades 6 & 7 for all height categories. There will be a separate qualifying competition for each height category.

There will be 10 separate heats for each height category, (small, medium, large) held at Kennel Club licensed shows, throughout the country.

The first 10 placed dogs in each heat will have the following points awarded: 1st place = 10 points, 2nd place = 9 points etc. to 10th place = 1 point. In the event of awards not going down to 10th place the Show Secretary should record the top ten places excluding eliminated dogs and send the results to the Crufts Office at the Kennel Club within 14 days of the show.

Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat. Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the final.

The 16 large dogs with the highest accumulation of points will be invited to compete in the CRUFTS Singles Large Agility Final at CRUFTS 2009. The 10 medium dogs with the highest accumulation of points will be invited to compete in the CRUFTS Singles Medium Agility Final at CRUFTS 2009. The 10 small dogs with the highest accumulation of points will be invited to compete in the CRUFTS Singles Small Agility Final at CRUFTS 2009.

EAGLE PACK ANNUAL AGILITY STARTER'S CUP GRADES 1 & 2 COMBINED LARGE DOGS

Approx Ten heats to be held at various Agility shows around the country with the final being held at Tuffley Agility Show July 2010 (Date to be confirmed). The first three placed dogs in each heat will be invited to go forward to the Final.

A Heat will be a Combined Grades 1 & 2 Large Dogs Agility. If a heat needs to be split, prizes will be offered in each part, with the first three placed dogs in each part being invited to go forward for the Final.

1st Prize – Trophy, Rosette and 15Kg Eagle Pack Original; **2nd Prize** – Trophy, Rosette and 7.5Kg Eagle Pack Original; **3rd Prize** – Trophy, Rosette and 3Kg Eagle Pack Original; **4th – 20th** Rosettes (or 10% of entry whichever is greater)

DOG SAFETY IN HOT CARS

In case of cancellation of the show within 7 days of the show date, notification will be sent to the relevant web sites where possible and notified to the iSS Show Hotline 07532 11 11 57. It will be the competitor's responsibility to check with the Hotline and/or the Web sites, if continuation of the show is in doubt.

Measuring: We are hoping to arrange measuring sessions over the weekend – please listen for announcements relating to when and where this will take place.

First Aid Cover: We have 2 First Aiders on standby for minor injuries, and maps to the local Accident and Emergency hospital for others. Please report initially to the secretary's tent, or your ring manager.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/ATC number will be required for each entry. Entries without a registration number/ATC number will be returned.
2. ENTRY FEES: Non-Members – Postal entries £2.80 per dog per class & £5.60 for Pairs. Non-member on-line entries £2.70 per dog per class, £5.40 for Pairs. Championship Class - £10; Camping - £20 (weekend charge including entry to entertainment). NFC – Free; Thames DTC Members - £1 per dog per class (Excl. Champ. Class) - £2 Pairs; Cheques made payable to THAMES DTC. Camping will be limited and priority given to those offering help.
3. There will be no prize money on offer at this show.
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible to compete for Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests.
6. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
7. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
8. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A flat close fitting leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
10. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
12. Sponsors of Classes include the Kennel Club, Pedigree, Eukanuba, CSJ, Premier and Aquadoggies. Prizes for classes are stated elsewhere.
13. Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations apply.
14. The heights of the jump obstacles will be as per Kennel Club Regulations with the exceptions that in Any Size Jumping, the jumps will be at 35cms for large dogs and lower for small/medium dogs, and Veterans at 45cms, 35cms & lowest available.
15. Judges at an Agility Test may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Test at which they are judging.
16. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is:-
 - a) A bitch which is in season
 - b) Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease
 - c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
 - d) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
17. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitors responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog should then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
18. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
19. All dogs must, at the time of entry for the Competition, be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitor's name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete as the new owner's property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.
20. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog whilst in the ring.
21. Ballot for Championship Class Running Orders.
 - a) Agility Round and Jumping Round - A draw for the running order of the Agility Round and Jumping Round must be made prior to the show. The relevant competitors must be notified before the day of the Show. The dogs must run in the order in which they are drawn. Points will be awarded for placings in the agility & jumping rounds. 1st place – 1 point, 2nd place – 2 points etc to the final placed dog, eliminated dogs excepted.
 - b) Final Agility Round – The top 50% of the entry to a maximum of 20 dogs with the lowest accumulated total will be eligible to compete in the final round. Elimination in either of the qualifying rounds will exclude the dog from competition in the final round.
 - c) A dog must have the same handler for each round of the Championship Agility Class.
22. A separate application for entry must be made by each owner and acceptance of the entry declaration must be given in accordance with the provisions specified thereon – whether in writing or via the internet www.ishowservices.com. Entries cannot be accepted without the appropriate fees or acceptance of the entry declaration.
23. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
24. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
25. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority To Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an authority to compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
26. Any Bank charges incurred as a result of incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques will be passed on to the exhibitor concerned.
27. All competitors MUST clear up after their dogs at all times. Failure to do so will result in competitors being asked to leave the Show.
28. All camping units MUST carry suitable fire extinguishers. A 20ft clear gap MUST be left between each unit. Joining of gardens is NOT allowed.
29. Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.
30. Dogs to be limited to 3 classes plus Pairs. Dogs entered in too many classes will be removed from the highest class for which they are eligible and no refunds will be offered.

31. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
32. A practice ring will be available if space allows.
33. The owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control, ie. held on a lead, whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches, except whilst competing or on the exercise area.
34. Championship competitors must indicate on the entry form if they wish their address to be withheld from publication.
35. No refunds can be given after close of entries. Bank Charges of £10 will be added to any cheques referred to drawer.
