## ELIGIBILITY AND SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

In accordance with KC Rules, large dogs that have not competed before 1st January 2006 & ALL Small & Medium dogs must have been officially measured before competing at a KC licensed Agility Show.

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Open Agility Shows (i.e. Limited Agility Shows, special classes and invitation events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round will count towards grade progression. A dog is only eligible for one grade. Agility classes to include contact points and Jumping classes where there are no contact obstacles. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

## DEFINITION OF CLASSES

**GRADE 1** : For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. *NB Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definitions apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

**GRADE 2** : Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1, 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *NB Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.*

**GRADE 3** : Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grades 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**GRADE 4** : Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

**GRADE 5** : Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 6 or 7.

**GRADE 6** : Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5 or 7.

**GRADE 7** : Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

**OPEN** : Open to all.

**A.B.C (SPECIAL CLASS)** : Open to all large dogs excluding border collies, working sheepdogs and their crosses. In the event of dispute, the judge's decision will be final.

## PROGRESSION

Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins at that grade, except that progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

## POINTS PROGRESSION

At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 5 by winning 75 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme, Regulation K3.c refers, except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however, once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

## **HEIGHT CLASSIFICATION OF DOGS**

Small Dogs: for dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers

Medium Dogs: for dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers

Large Dogs: for dogs measuring over 430mm at the withers.

## **SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/Authority to Compete number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry fees are as detailed on the Entry Form.
3. Prizes – no monetary prizes are on offer. Awards for each class are listed in the awards section of the schedule.
4. The Working Belgian Shepherd Dog Society Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible to compete for Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows
6. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
7. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
8. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
10. Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges. The judge's decision will be final; no competitor will be allowed to influence that in any way, and the show committee will stand by the judge's decision in all cases.
12. - Sponsors for the show are listed on the schedule
13. Kennel Club standard marking Regulations will apply as published in the Kennel Club Yearbook in use at the time of the show, including any amendments introduced by the Kennel Club.
14. The height limits for dogs are:
  - a. Large dogs – for dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers
  - b. Medium dogs – for dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers
  - c. Small dogs – for dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
15. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog that is recorded in their ownership or part ownership, or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging.
16. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Show if it is:-
  - a. A bitch which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
17. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog should then be moved into the appropriated class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
18. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
19. Dogs must at the time of entry for competition, be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitor's name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete as the new owner's property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.
20. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the Show Society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.

21. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the competitor.
22. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
23. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
24. A practice ring will be available if space allows.
25. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
26. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees
27. Dogs will not be received for competition after the class has been declared closed.
28. Please clean up after your dog and place in bins provided. Anyone knowingly not doing so may be asked to leave the venue and will forfeit any remaining class entries.
29. In the event of abandonment of the Show through circumstances beyond our control, the organising group may defray such expenses as necessary from the entry fees to cover the cost of the Show preparation.
30. No refunds due to incorrect entries, or requests for special running orders, will be entertained.
31. All competitors who enter any special classes agree to the rules as defined in the schedule by WBSDS
32. Competitors must follow the stewards' instructions with regard to parking, camping and conduct within the show boundaries.
33. Goods may NOT be sold within the precincts of the show without prior permission of WBSDS
34. Rosettes and Trophies can only be collected on the day of the show and will NOT be forwarded.
35. Dogs are limited to 4 classes per day. (excluding juniors)

### **Welfare of Dogs**

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dogs.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

### **CAMPING:**

- Available for a fixed fee of £12 for the weekend. Please include your camping fees of £12.00 with your entries.
- Please send a separate cheque for your camping fee, which we can return or shred in the event that the camping is fully booked at the time that your entry is received.
- The envelope containing your running orders will be your camping pass showing your permitted time of arrival. It is essential that you carry this with you as there will be security at the site entrance
- Only campers who have paid in advance will be allowed in the camping area
- **No camping units allowed on the showground before 3.00pm on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2009**
- Please arrive on the Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2009 before 9.00pm to book in
- **NOTE : The gates to the venue will be shut between 9pm and 7am each night**
- We regret that camping will not be available for Sunday night and we request that the site is cleared by 7.30pm
- Please leave a minimum space of 20 feet between units
- Training equipment is not allowed in the camping areas
- The joining of gardens is prohibited
- No dogs to be left loose in gardens, or tethered to vehicles, whilst unattended
- Fire extinguishers will be sited around the venue
- All camping units are required to have a bucket of water at the front of the unit at all times
- There are toilets on site, plus an emptying point for chemical toilets

### **HEATS**

The first three placed dogs in each heat will be invited to go forward to the Final.

A Heat will be a Combined Grades 1 & 2 Large Dogs Agility. If a heat needs to be split, prizes will be offered in each part, with the first three placed dogs in each part being invited to go forward for the Final.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize** – Trophy, Rosette and 15Kg Eagle Pack Original
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize** – Trophy, Rosette and 7.5Kg Eagle Pack Original
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize** – Trophy, Rosette and 3Kg Eagle Pack Original
- 4<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>** Rosettes (or 10% of entry whichever is greater)

### **Eagle Pack Annual Agility Starters Cup** **Rules & Regulations**

- Eligibility for competition is under the Kennel Club classification and is open to dogs Working Grades One and Two Large Dog Agility.
- The competition must be judged under the appropriate Kennel Club Rules in force at the time of the event.
- Competitors entering the competition must be deemed to have agreed to abide by those Rules and Regulations
- Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the Final.
- Each heat is open to all competitors eligible for Grades 1 & 2 Large Dogs.
- Qualifiers may enter further heats for competition, providing they are still eligible for Grades 1 and 2.
- Handlers who gain a place in a heat with a previously qualified dog should inform the Eagle Pack representative on the day of the show of this fact.
- The competition will consist of approx'10 heats with the first 3 placed dogs from each heat going through to the final. In the event of someone qualifying more than once for the final, the next placed eligible dog will be taken from the appropriate heat.
- Should someone be unable to attend the Final the next placed eligible Dog may be invited at the sponsor's discretion
- Surrogate Handlers will not be allowed.
- We reserve the right to publish any photos of the events, dogs & handlers in our promotional material without obligation.

## DIRECTIONS TO VENUE :

**Directions from South & East** – From the end of the M54 follow the signs for North Wales (A5) bypassing Shrewsbury until you reach Oswestry. At the roundabout take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit signposted Wrexham A5/A483 (North Wales). At the next roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit (A495) signposted Whittington. Take the first turning left and drive to the end of the road (day parking will be using this entrance over the two days).

**Directions from North and North East** – From M53 take the A55 exit at A483 towards Wrexham follow this until you reach A5 (road changes from A483 to A5). Continue along A5 until you reach roundabout signed posted Whittington/Ellesmere take the first left and after a few yards take the first left again and follow road down to Showground (day parkers will be using this entrance over the two days).
