NOTE: A pay on the day class and/or a practise ring may be held on both days, time and weather permitting.

TROPHIES & PRIZES

Clear round rosettes in all classes.

Trophy for 1st place in a class with entries up to 20

Trophies for 1st and 2nd place in a class with entries between 20 and 50

Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in classes with entries over 50

Trophies for 1st to 4th place in class 15 only

STANDARD CLASSES. *Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.*

ELIGIBILITY

- Grade 1: For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.
- Grade 2: Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7, and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.
- Grade 3: Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows & dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.
- Grade 4: Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.
- Grade 5: Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.
- Grade 6: Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5 or 7.
- Grade 7: Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

In accordance with Kennel Club Rules, all newly competing dogs must have been officially measured before competing at this show.

Small: Open to dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.

Medium: Open to dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.

Large: Open to dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.

NBC: 'Nothing But Collies' Open to large dogs that are Border Collies, Working Sheepdog or their crosses, as recorded on the Kennel Club Registration form.

ABC: 'Anything But Collies' Open to all large dogs except Border Collies, Working Sheepdogs or their crosses.

Tunnel Vision Classes: The course will consist of only jumps and tunnels.

Helter Skelter Classes: The course will be a jumping course consisting of obstacles placed in a circular motion.

Any Size Jumping: Open to dogs not entered in any other Class on that day at the Show.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Dogs that are entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for classification and Registration B. The registration number/authority to compete number will be required for each entry.
- Entry fees are £2.25 per dog per class and £4.50 per pair, camping is £15 for the weekend.
- There is no prize money.
- The committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- Classes 15, 16 & 17 are supported by Eukanuba and classes 3, 10 & 14 are supported by the Agility Club
- All dogs resident outside the United Kingdom must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to compete number will be returned to the competitor.
- Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.
- Not for Competition entries are free and will be accepted for dogs aged 4 months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
- The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
- No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
- Dogs must not wear any type of slip chains, half-slip collars or leads when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
- Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge or judges.
- No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
- Standard marking in accordance with the current Kennel Club rules shall apply.
- A judge at a Kennel Club Licensed Agility Show cannot enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the test at which they are judging.
- A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the show if it is:
 - A bitch which is in season
 - Suffering from any infectious or contagious diseases
 - Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
 - Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal
 - Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing
- The owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at a Kennel Club licensed event must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control i.e. held on lead, whilst at the licensed venue, including its precinct, car and caravan parks and approaches, except whilst competing or on the exercise area. Plus no dog will be allowed in the ring at any time other than when being judged.
- In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition shall be counted when entering for any classes. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretariat at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class/classes for the next grade. The dog will be moved into the corresponding number of classes, if available, as were entered at the lower grade.
- Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Dogs will be received, at the judges discretion, until the management closes the class.
- Should circumstances so dictate, the Club, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.

22. A dog must at the time of entry for the Competition be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations in the Competitors' name (or registration of transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a competition may compete as the new owner's property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the competition, and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.
23. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
24. No animal other than the one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by special permission of the General Committee and organisers of the event. Precincts of the show are the rings and a distance of 2 meters bordering the rings.
25. In all matters concerning the competition, the judge's discretion will be final; in all other matters, the decision of the show secretary will be final.
26. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the committee may defray such expenses from the entry fees to cover the cost of the show preparation.
27. Separate entry forms must be completed by each competitor and must be signed by the competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
28. No dogs suffering from contagious or infectious diseases or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the competition may compete. Competitors infringing the regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
29. Campers must keep to their allocated space and must not obstruct the roadways.
30. All dogs will be entered in the show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken the Committee will not accept any responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, person or property while at the show.
31. Adults with accompanying children are expected to be responsible for the children's behaviour and actions whilst at the show.
32. Internet entries will be accepted via www.LNshowservices.co.uk.
33. If you wish your entry returned because camping is full this must be indicated on the entry form and sae enclosed.
34. All lost property will be retained for two weeks after which it will be disposed of.

Welfare of Dogs – Any exhibitor or (competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

EUKANUBA MINI CIRCULAR KNOCK-OUT


The competition is open to mini dogs, known as small dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.

EUKANUBA MINI AGILITY CHALLENGE

The competition is open to mini dogs, known as small dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.

EUKANUBA MINI/MIXI PAIRS CHALLENGE

The competition is open to mini dogs, known as small dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers, partnering either a midi dog, known as a medium dog measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers or a maxi dog, known as a large dog measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers. The competition will involve a change of height of the obstacle being jumped by the midi/maxi dogs at one stage during the class. The judge will decide which height of jump to start with and will announce the change of height when relevant. It is the competitors responsibility to be available accordingly. The course will be walked by everyone before the beginning of the class.



STARTERS AGILITY CHALLENGE - 2009/2010 RULES

1. The classes should be billed appropriately as either "The Agility Club Large Starters Challenge, supported by Pedigree", "The Agility Club Medium Starters Challenge, supported by Pedigree" or "The Agility Club Small Starters Challenge, supported by Pedigree" and scheduled accordingly as a Large, Medium or Small combined Grade 1-2 Agility class.
2. The competition will be run under the relevant Kennel Club Regulations in force at that time. All handlers will be deemed to have agreed to abide by these rules and regulations.
3. Each Heat is open to all Grade 1-2 dogs of the correct size for each heat, but only those handled by an Agility Club member at the time of competing may qualify for the Final.
4. The competition will normally consist of between ten and fifteen Heats. The two highest placed Agility Club members in each Heat will go through to the Final, subject to the restriction that both handler and dog may only qualify once for each height Final.
5. The show secretary must be informed if a handler or dog that has already qualified for the same height Final is placed in a subsequent Heat.

On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after it's name.
