Each agility class will contain all 3 pieces of equipment, plus 12 weaves

All classes will be a grade 1-4 courses aimed more at grade 2 so perfect for beginners. Please indicate on your entry form if you are a beginner (grade 1-3) or advanced (grade 4-7) for the league results. Points will be allocated in all 3 classes over the 4 shows towards the league.

You may run for competition at one height lower than you are eligible for. You may use a toy or food for NFC rounds but please do not use any treats which may crumble and be careful not to drop anything which may distract other dogs. NFC runs will be given 60 seconds in the ring. Dogs may compete at only one height for the duration of the show. All three classes at the chosen height must be entered.

The course for each class will be the same for all heights and can be walked before the start of each class – there will be no chance for walking the course outside of the allotted time.

Please note that dogs do not need to be KC registered to enter the show and do not need to be officially measured.

Dog Height Categories and Jump Heights

Small: dogs measuring 350mm and below - Jump height 300mm.

Medium: dogs measuring over 350mm and below 430mm - Jump height 400mm.

Intermediate: dogs measuring over 430mm and below 500mm – Jump height 500mm.

Large: dogs measuring over 500mm – Jump height 600mm.

Awards

Rosettes will be awarded in all classes to third place.

Results will be split by height, but may be combined for small & medium dogs and intermediate & large dogs, if class entries are small. League points will still be awarded per height.

There will be a league over the 4 shows and all placings up to 5th, irrespective of faults, will gain points towards this. All clear rounds will gain points towards the league.

Clear round prizes will be available for all classes, please collect these before you leave.

Placed rosettes and prizes will be posted out after the show has finished. Please ensure that your correct postal address is on your entry form. Alternatively rosettes and prizes can be taken to another show/training for collection.

League points are as followed;

Agility - 1st = 15, 2nd = 12, 3rd = 9, 4th = 6, 5th = 3, CR = 3

Jumping - 1st = 10, 2nd = 8, 3rd = 6, 4th = 4, 5th = 2, CR = 2

Steeplechase - 1st = 5, 2nd = 4, 3rd = 3, 4th = 2, 5th = 1, CR = 1

Exercise Area

Due to our restrictions about how many people can be at our venue at the same time, please do not arrive for your time slot more than 15 minutes early. There will be a designated 'toilet' area for your dogs. Please do not let your dogs pee on the fencing and stables. There are two footpaths next to the venue where you can exercise your dog off lead. Please do not let your dog off lead onsite unless competing.

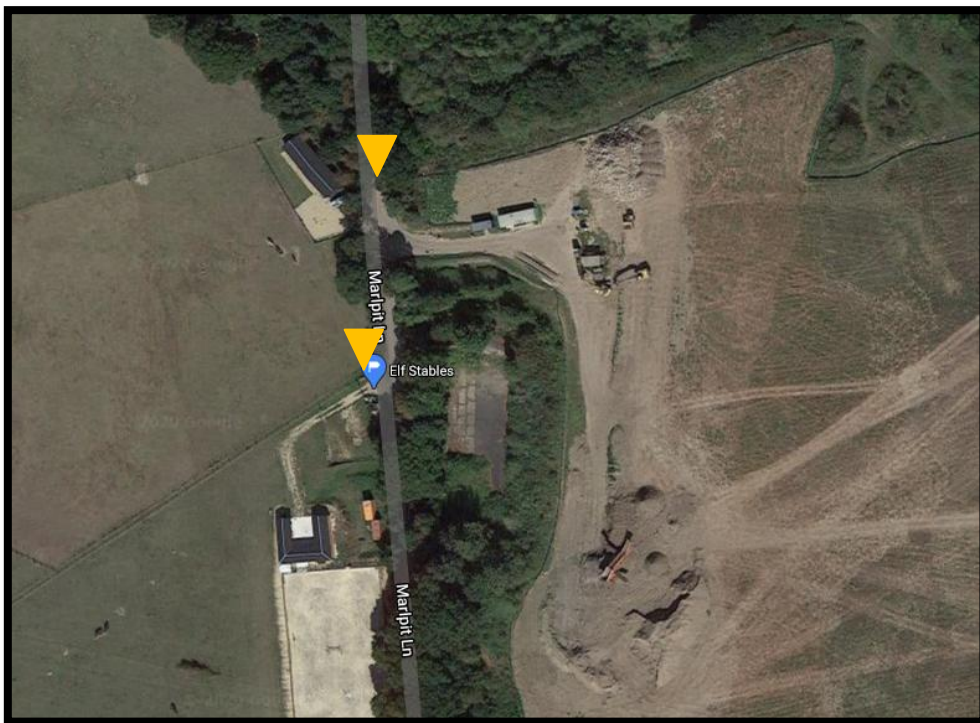
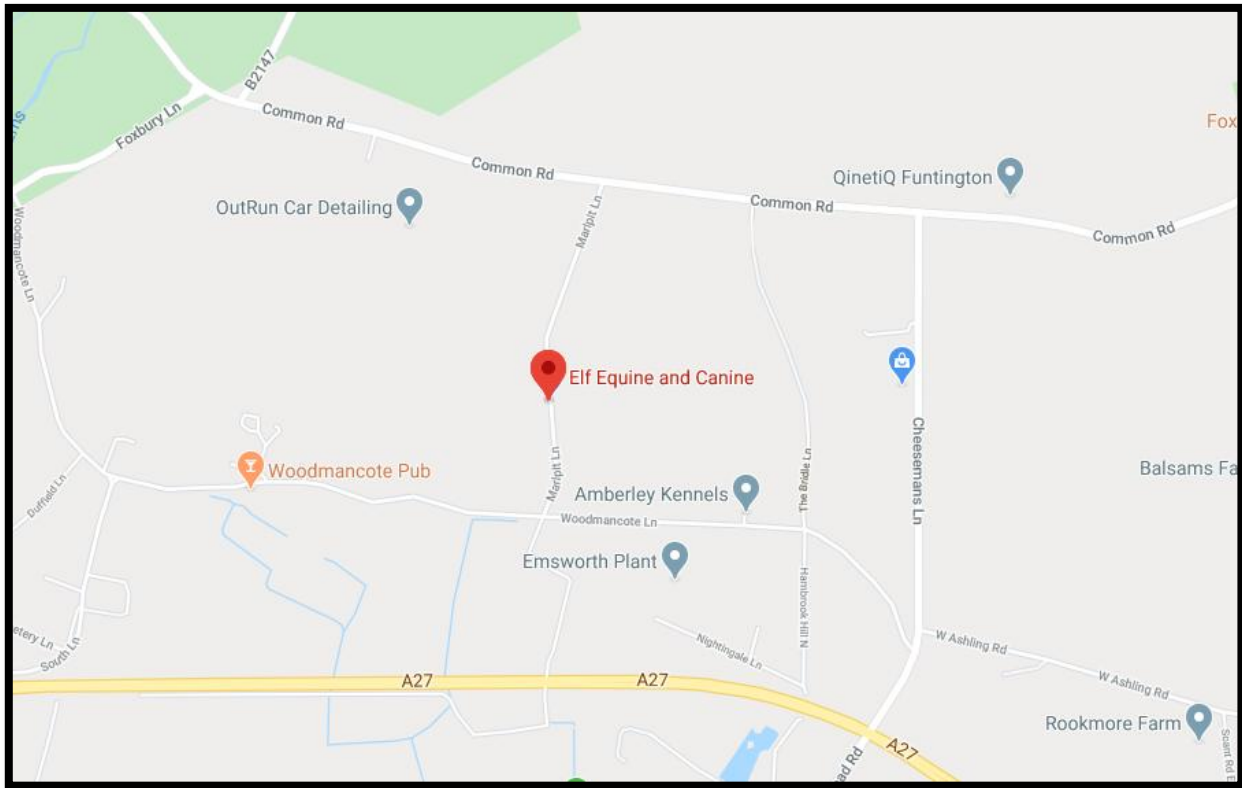
Show Rules

Please read our show rules carefully. By entering the show, you agree to abide by them!

1. We reserve the right to refuse entries.
2. Entries limited to 60 dogs per day. If the maximum number of dogs is reached before the official closing date, entries will be declared closed at that earlier date.
3. Changes may be made to the level or height your dog is entered into after sending your entry, but only up to and including the closing date of the show. Please email elfequineandcanine@gmail.com with your changes to your entry.
4. Please keep all dogs on lead (except when competing) and ensure you clean up after your dogs.
5. All dogs entered for competition at this show must be 16 months of age or over.
6. Any person handling their own or any other dog in a harsh manner will be asked to leave the show.
7. A dog will be removed from the competition if it is: so out of control that it poses a danger to people or dogs at the show; or suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, or otherwise unfit to compete.
8. The show manager and show secretary will be the sole arbiters in respect of all matters and disputes at this event.
9. Competitors must follow the written instructions of the show with respect to parking and conduct within the show boundaries.
10. In the event that the competition has to be cancelled, we reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.
11. Whilst every care will be taken, we will not take responsibility for loss, damage or injury to dogs, people or property whilst at this show.
12. Goods may not be sold at the venue without prior permission.
13. By entering you agree that your and your dogs photos and/or video may be taken and used by Elf Equine and Canine as they see fit, including for advertisement purposes.
14. Running orders will be sent out in advance of the show by email. It is your responsibility to make sure you are available to run in your allocated time slot. Failure to arrive in time for your slot may mean you miss walking the course and/or you are unable to run in your classes.
15. Standard marking will apply for all classes.
16. Eligibility for classes and rules for training and competition rounds can be found on page 2 of this schedule.
17. For the purposes of show processing and scoring at the event, your details will be recorded on paper and stored in accordance with GDPR. Show results will be published online on the Facebook page and can be emailed by request.

19. By entering this show, you agree to abide by all government guidance regarding social distancing. Failure to comply with government guidance will result in you being asked to leave the show without refund.
20. Handlers must bring their own hand gel and are responsible for their own belongings at all times during the show.

21. If you are entering more than one dog at different heights, please state this at the time of entry. Failure to do so may result in you being unable to run both dogs in the same timeslot. Please state if you wish to run your dogs in the same time slot or in separate time slots.
22. Competitors MUST arrive on time, please do not arrive before your "do not arrive before" time. If you arrive late, you risk forfeiting your runs and no refunds will be available in this event. When you have finished your runs, please leave promptly as parking is limited.
23. Please ensure that you allow your dog(s) the opportunity to toilet before entering the rings. There will be an allocated toilet area where you may walk your dogs between runs. Please pick up after your dog and make sure that your dog does not run alongside the agility rings.
24. You may choose not to run all three classes, however all entries will be automatically entered for all runs.
25. When you enter the ring, the scribe will confirm your name and dog's name. Please ensure that this information is correct before commencing your run.
26. Final results will be published within 48 hours of the event on the [Elf Equine and Canine](#) Facebook page.
27. Everyone must adhere to the Government guidelines on Covid and social distancing rule at all times.
